**ROUTE OVERVIEW**

These walks on woodland tracks, gravel and grassy paths, meander through the trees in the mature natural woodlands of Lough Conn opening up at a clearing by the lakeshore.

Green Loop	
Distance:	3.7 km
Height gain:	10 metres
Estimated Time:	30 - 60 minutes
Terrain:	Virtually level, along woodland tracks and gravel and grassy paths through mature natural woodlands.
Grading:	Easy: Trail is generally flat with a smooth surface but with occasional gentle slopes or shallow steps. Generally suitable for family groups including children and the elderly. Normal outdoor footwear can be worn.
Waymarking:	Green arrows on a black background.

Purple Loop	
Distance:	2.7 km
Height gain:	10 metres
Estimated Time:	20 - 50 minutes
Terrain:	Virtually level, along woodland tracks and gravel and grassy paths through mature natural woodlands.
Grading:	Easy: Trail is generally flat with a smooth surface but with occasional gentle slopes or shallow steps. Generally suitable for family groups including children and the elderly. Normal outdoor footwear can be worn.
Waymarking:	Purple arrows on a black background.

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
